



PARTICIPATING PHOTOGRAPHER'S TERMS AND CONDITIONS

USE OF IMAGES

In order to qualify for the photographer's price and receive the photographer's price, you are expected to submit a minimum of 20 images per safari. David Anderson Safaris, and all U.S. and African sponsors will have the right to use your images for promotional purposes. Should the rights to use your images be sold to a third party, the photographer will receive up to a 40% of the revenue from the sale. You will retain the copyright to your images and all other rights. We make no guarantees that your images will be used or published.

VIDEO-PHOTOGRAPHERS

Video-photographers are expected to shoot with a HD-Video camera and submit digital "footage" that Focus on Africa can use to promote sustainable ecotourism, community development, and conservation. No footage will be sold or used commercially.

CAMERA EQUIPMENT

Photographers agree to use a 35mm SLR or medium format camera on safari and to have a minimum of one lens with a focal length of at least 200mm to be eligible for the photographer's discount. Digital cameras must have a minimum resolution of 6.0 mega-pixels.

MODEL RELEASES

By signing this agreement, you are also giving us the rights to publish images of you.

RESPECTING THE CULTURE

Participants are expected to respect the privacy of people you will meet on safari. This applies not only to the African people, but also to the tourists who have traveled to Africa to experience a safari. Participants should not do anything that would upset the cultures of Africa or disturb the environment.

TIMETABLE FOR SUBMITTING IMAGES

All images must be submitted within 60 days of the end of your safari.

CREDITS

Appropriate credits will be given to the photographer whose images are used.

DIGITAL FORMAT

Images must be submitted on a CD or DVD. Slides and prints are not acceptable. If you shoot slides or prints, the images must be scanned as a jpeg and put on a CD or DVD. The minimum file size is 6 megabytes.

SHOT LIST

Each participating photographer will receive a list of images we are seeking. These will include wildlife, birds, accommodations, tribal people, tourists, landscapes, guides and more. The list will assist you in capturing the images and thus increase your chance of having your images chosen for publication.

PHOTOGRAPHER'S AGREEMENT:

Photographers who fail to honor these terms and agreements will be invoiced for the discount they received on their safari.
